(13) To borrow in my behalf and in my name any funds needed by me and to pledge for the payment thereof any stocks, bonds or securities or other property owned by me.

(14) To purchase medicine, clothes, food or other supplies for my benefit.

And, in general, the said CELESTED. TEIE, as my attorney-in-fact. is given full power and authority to do and perform all and every act or thing whatsoever requisite or necessary to be done for my upkeep, care and maintenance and for the management of any property owned by me, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, and I hereby ratify and confirm all that said CELESTE D. TEIE, as my attorneyin-fact, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue hereof, it being my intent and purpose to confer upon my said attorney-in-fact the broadest possible powers to be used and exercised in the discretion of my attorneyin-fact for my use and benefit.

The powers herein granted shall be deemed continuing and relate as fully to any property which I may hereafter acquire, as to any property I may now own, and the powers herein conferred may be exercised repeatedly.

And for the protection of all parties dealing with my said attorney-in-fact, I do hereby agree that this power of attorney shall be and remain in full force and effect until revoked by me in writing, which revocation shall be recorded in the Office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County, South Carolina.
