ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville and being known as Lot No. 17, Block G on a Plat of VILLAGE OF S. SLATER & SONS recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, South Carolina in Plat Book K, at Page 63 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
