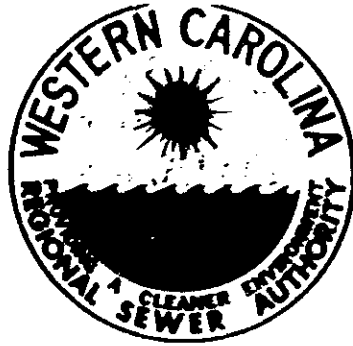

Dear Mr. Bolen:

A sewer trunk line is located near the property you have identified (540.1-1-7,8) for a proposed 60 unit condominium project. The line near Rocky Creek south of the property is available for use under the following provisions:

- (1) Permits are obtained from the appropriate agencies involved with the collection system, including Metropolitan Sewer Subdistrict and the SCDHEC.
- (2) The system is otherwise constructed in accordance with the WCRSA regulations.
- (3) Provided the upgrade of the Rocky Creek treatment plant has progressed to the point of having sufficient plant capacity.

The Rocky Creek plant has recently experienced flows in excess of the design capacity. The WCRSA has received a grant for design of an upgrade to this plant and anticipates construction without delay, however due to technical considerations in the design, other alternatives for providing increased treatment capacity are being evaluated.

The WCRSA plans to provide treatment services within the basin in such a way that no development delays will be incurred, however, at this time the exact date of the additional capacities being available is not known. It could be more than six months however.
