fully and effectively to all intents and purposes as I could do in my own proper person if personally present.

14. This Power of Attorney shall not be effected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.

I do hereby ratify and confirm all things whatsoever my said attorney or such substitute or substitutes, shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents, including anything which shall be done between the revocation of these presents by my death, or in any other manner, and notice of such revocation reaches my said attorney; and I hereby declare that as against me and all persons claiming under me, everything which my said attorney shall do, or cause to be done, after such revocation as aforesaid, shall be valid and effective in favor of any person claiming the benefit thereof who, before the doing thereof shall not have had the notice of such revocation.
