

S. $71\frac{1}{2}$ W. 2.88 chains to stone 3xo, bounded on the last four lines by church lot; thence N. $36\text{-}\frac{3}{4}$ W. 2.88 chains to stone 3xo, bounded by tract of Jean Knight; thence N. 34-35 E. 21.00 chains to stone 3xo; thence N. 27-35 E. 4.95 chains to stone x; thence S. $74\frac{1}{2}$ E. 5.75 chains to stone 3xo; thence S. $84\text{-}\frac{3}{4}$ E. 15.60 chains to stone 3xo; thence S. 65 E. 8.50 chains to stone xo; thence S. 25 E. 6.60 chains to stone xo; thence S. 1 E. 11-75 chains to stone xo; thence S. $7\text{-}\frac{3}{4}$ W. 3.28 chains to stone xo; thence S. 15 W. 12.50 chains to stone x on school branch; thence up said branch which is the line N. $86\text{-}\frac{1}{3}$ W. 3.35 chains to angle; thence N. $65\text{-}\frac{1}{3}$ W. 13.15 chains to angle; thence N. 80-50 W. 11.36 chains to beginning corner and containing 128.27 acres, more or less.

ALSO, a small piece of land lying on school branch, described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stone and running thence N. $18\frac{3}{4}$ E. 640 to a post oak on a stone; thence N. $62\frac{1}{2}$ N. 35.90 to a pine 3x, old painters; thence S. 9 W. to stone x3; thence S. 80 E. 33.06 to beginning corner and containing 39.49 acres, more or less, and bounded by lands of W. V. Kirby, J. B. Thompson and J. E. Knight and others.

ALSO, ALL that other tract of land containing $64\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, known as the Young tract, situate in Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a corner in the rear and running thence N. $52\frac{1}{2}$ W. 25.12 to poplar stump 3xo; thence S. $33\frac{1}{2}$ W. 6.90 iron 3xo, bounded by a tract conveyed to R. A. Knight; thence S. $86\frac{9}{10}$ E. 37.53 to a stake 3xo; thence N. 73 E. 17.77 to a corner in the road,
