

restricted to allowances and reimbursements for transportation of dependents or for shipment of household effects as authorized by law and applicable regulations and to receive, endorse, and collect the proceeds of checks payable to the order of the undersigned drawn on the Treasury of the United States; (10) to prepare, execute, and file income and other tax returns and other governmental reports, applications, requests, and documents; (11) to authorize; provide; or obtain any and all medical services; care; tests; or other associated physical; psychological; or medical assistance I might require, to include but not limited to administration of drugs; conducting of tests; the performance of surgery, both minor and major; the transfusion of blood; taking of x-rays and other diagnostic tests; and commission to nursing homes or other nursing aftercare facilities.

GIVING AND GRANTING upon my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act, deed, matter, and thing whatsoever in and about my estate, property, and affairs as fully and effectually to all intents and purposes as I might or could do in my own proper person if personally present, the above specifically enumerated powers being in aid and exemplification of the full and complete and general power herein granted and not in limitation or definition thereof; and hereby ratifying all that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal which renders the principal incapable of managing his own estate.

AND I HEREBY declare that any act or thing lawfully done hereunder by my said attorney shall be binding upon myself and my heirs, legal and personal representatives, and assigns, whether the same shall have been done before or after my death, or other revocation of this instrument, unless and until reliable intelligence or notice thereof shall have been received by my said attorney.

This power shall be in perpetuity.
