Subject property was placed in trust by Grantor and Grantee by that certain Declaration of Trust recorded September 11, 1967, in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 828, Page 149. This trust provided that any proceeds derived from the sale of subject property would be held in trust for the use and benefit of Melrose Foster, during his lifetime. That Melrose Foster, the father of Grantor and Grantee, died intestate in Greenville County on April 5, 1976. the terms of said Declaration of Trust, subject property is now vested in Grantor and Grantee; and they do not recognize that such property is subject to any debts of the Estate of Melrose Foster. That although the subject property is vested in Grantee and Grantor, as an extra matter of precaution and in order to add information to the Courthouse records, this correction deed is recorded and the Grantor is signing individually and as Trustee under the above referred to Trust Declaration.
