

Attorney. The word attorney as used herein shall include both the singular and the plural as the facts or circumstances may indicate.

9. This power of attorney shall not be affected by physical disability or mental incompetence of the principal, Myrtle Phillips Prince, which renders the principal incapable of managing her own estate. It is the intent of the principal to create a durable power of attorney conferring upon James Earle Prince, Sr. attorney in fact the power to act on behalf of the principal notwithstanding later disability or mental incompetence of the principal, pursuant to the authority of Section 32-13-10 of the 1976b Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended.
