In making such payments from income, the Trustees may take into account any other income that such named beneficiary may have received or be receiving from other sources known to such Trustees, and whether or not such income is sufficient for said purposes. Such determination of the Trustees as hereinabove authorized shall be final and binding upon all persons then or thereafter interested in this Trust.

When the youngest named beneficiary reaches the age of twenty-five (25) years (or if all such beneficiaries have reached the age of twenty-five (25) years), then the entire Trust Estate as then constituted shall be paid over and distributed to the named beneficiaries in equal shares, per stirpes.

VI.

Whenever the Trustees, in their sole discretion, determine that the income of any named beneficiary from all sources known to the Trustees is not sufficient for his comfortable support and education, the Trustees may pay to him, or use for his benefit, so much of the principal of the Trust as the Trustees determine to be reasonably required therefor. In addition, the Trustees may, in their sole discretion, from time to time distribute to any of the named beneficiaries, or use for his benefit, any portion or all of the principal of the Trust for his welfare or enjoyment, for the purchase of a home, for use in business, to enable him to assume responsibility for the management of his own affairs, or to make
