FOURTH: Should my husband Roy D. Gresham, predecease me, or should he and I die together in one common fatality, calamity or accident, then and in either event, I do hereby nominate and appoint Margaret Hendrix, Route 2, Greenville, South Carolina to be the guardian of the person and estate of my said minor children until they shall become of age, conferring upon her full power and authority to manage the guardianship estate to the best advantage of my said minor children.

FIFTH: I do hereby nominate, constitute and appoint Roy D. Gresham, as Executor of this, my LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT. In the event of the death, resignation or incapacity of my husband, Roy D. Gresham, I then appoint Alan H. Stocksdale, as Executor in his place and stead. I request that either of my Executors, be excused from the necessity of giving bond for the faithful performance of their duties, other than the nominal bond required by law.

SIXTH: In order to facilitate the management, distribution and administration of my said estate, while the same shall remain in the hands of my said Executors, I do hereby give unto and do hereby confer and bestow upon my said Executors full and complete power to sell any and all of my property and estate, whether real, personal or mixed, at either public or private sale, for such price or prices and on such terms as to my said Executors shall seem right and proper, and to mortgage, lease, exchange, transfer, and in any other manner whatsoever, manage or deal with the same or any part or parts thereof, and that without the nec-
