- 2.4 All fuel oil tanks or containers shall be revered or buried underground consistent with normal safety probabilists.
- oh any lot in this subdivision except (nat cata, dogs, rabbits, hamsters or caged birds may be kept in reasonable numbers as pets for the pleasure of the occupants. The Architectural Committee is authorized (but not required) to issue reasonable rules for the protection of all (where in this subdivision relating to the number of nots which ray be kept on any numbered lot.
- 2.6 Garbage and trash cans, wood piles, clothes drying yards, dog houses or pet yards or cages must be so located that they will not be visible from the street.
- 2.7 Property owners will be required to keep till shrubbery or hedges trimmed to reasonable limits so that air circulation or view from surrounding property will not be adversely affected or where traffic hazards may be created.
- 2.8 Provisions must be made by the property owners for off-street parking of cars belonging to domestic servants as the parking of such cars on street rights-of-way for long periods of time during the day or night will not be permitted.
- 2.9 No house trailer or mobile home shall be placed on any lot either temporarily or permanently. All boats, trailers and vehicles, including automobiles, trucks, buses, vans, camping trailers, and motor homes, must be parked, other than temporarily (and in all events not over night), in carports or garages so as to be inconspicuous and not disturb the neighbors. However, passenger automobiles may also be parked in driveways or paved parking areas since carports or garages for passenger automobiles are not required.
