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POWER OF ATTORNEY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that I, MARY ELIZABETH NORRIS, of the County and State aforesaid, hereinafter referred to as "Principal", have constituted and appointed, and by these presents do make, constitute and appoint JACK H.
