This Indenture made on the fourth day of July Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine, and in the Thirteenth year of America Independence, Between Joseph Doughty of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, Yeoman of the one part, and Reuben Barrett of the State and County aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that in and by a certain grant bearing date the fifth day of February Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and eighty nine under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire Governor and commander in chief in and over the said State, having the great seal of the State thereunto affixed did give and grant unto Joseph Doughty a tract of land containing one hundred acres situate in the said County on without Creek a branch of South Tugger River, bounding on John Lucas's land all other sides vacant, and hath such forms and marks appears by a plat to the said grant annexed said grant being duly recorded in the Secretarys office reference thereunto had may more fully appear Now this Indenture Witnesseth that said Joseph Doughty for and in consideration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Reuben Barrett the receipt thereof is hereby acknowledged the said
