


South Carolina Greenville County August the Eighteenth One thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, A Deed of conveyance for twenty acres of land from Thomas Jenkins Esq, to James Harrison Esq, having been acknowledged before Robert Maxwell Esq, produced in open court and ordered to be recorded.

State of South Carolina This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of May in the year of our Lord One thousand Seven hundred and eighty nine, B.E. between Thomas Jenkins of Ninety six district and Greenville County of the one part and James Harrison of the said district and County of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Thomas Jenkins for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds lawful Sterling money, to him in hand well and truly made and paid before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said James Harrison the receipt whereof the said Thomas Jenkins doth hereby acknowledge and thereof and of and from every part and parcel thereof do acquit and discharge the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns and for divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving have granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents do grant bargain sell enfeoff and confirm unto the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns forever Twenty acres of land being part of a Tract of land originally granted unto William Hogins and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the third day of April one thousand Seven hundred and eighty six Including the said James Harrison's dwelling house and beginning on a post oak corner also the corner of a tract of land surveyed for and granted to Jane Cambell, from thence on the said line made for Jane Cambell, North East thence by four degrees, fourteen chains and five links, from thence North West Sixty Six degrees fourteen chains and five links, from thence South West twenty four degrees fourteen chains and five links to the said Harrison's line and from thence to the beginning, containing Twenty acres. Together with all and singular the Houses outhouses ways waters paths passages trees fences easements hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said parcel or part of the said tract of land so described as above belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion and reversions remainder and remainders rents issues and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof and all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever both in law and equity of the said Thomas Jenkins of in and to the said premises and of in and to every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said parcel of land and all and singular other the premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said James Harrison his heirs and assigns forever. And lastly the said Thomas Jenkins for himself and his heirs the said parcel of land and all and singular the premises above granted with their appurtenances unto the said James Harrison and his heirs against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend.
