 of Saluda River bounding on Southwest on land laid out for John  
 Goodwyn party hereto, and all <sup>the</sup> sides by vacant land at the time of  
 Surveying and hath such shapes and marks as by the plat annexed  
 to the grant thereof made to the said David Reid Evans the 10<sup>th</sup> day of July  
 1784 reference being thereunto had will more fully appear Together  
 with all and singular the orchards fences ways wells waters water courses  
 Easements profits commodities advantages Emoluments hereditaments  
 and appurtenances whatsoever to the said plantation or tract of land  
 belonging or in anywise appertaining and the reversion and reversions
