Elhunny and Margaret his wife on the one part, and John Morrow on the other both of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County Witnesseth that the said James M. Elhunny for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pound Sterling to him in hand paid the receipt and payment whereof is hereby fully acknowledged, hath given granted and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell alien and release convey and confirm unto the said John Morrow and to his heirs and assigns forever, a certain peice tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid on the South side of the North fork of Saluda the compliment of acres unknown being all that part of the plantation or tract of land that he the said James M. Elhunny now lives on that lies on the South side of the aforesaid North fork of Saluda River from the lower end of the said plantation or tract of land up to the first small creek and no further, which said land was granted unto the said James M. Elhunny the sixteenth day of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty four, and duly recorded in the Secretarys office as by reference thereunto had may more fully and at large appear.
