150 The following Deed of conveyance from Obadiah Hooper to Samuel Gordon was proven before Robert Nelson Esquire by the oath of Septha Hollingworth and Recorded this 25th March A 1790

This Indenture made this third day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty Nine between Obadiah Hooper Jun^r of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part and Samuel Gordon of the State and County aforesaid Wmoseeth that the said Obadiah Hooper for divers good causes and considerations of the Just sum of five shillings to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Gordon unto the said Obadiah Hooper hath Granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth Grant bargain Sell and confirm unto the said Samuel Gordon his heirs Executors Administrators and assigns a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing six hundred Acres be the same more or less and hath such Shape forms marks bounding and boundings (viz) Beginning on a black Oak on the South Side of the Enore River thence North Forty East Forty Chain thence North Seventy five East Twenty five chain and fifty link to a stake thence North forty west thirty seven chain and eighty link to a black Oak corner thence South eighty one west eighty Two chain and Seventy links to a black Oak thence South ten East forty nine chain and fifty links to a
