The following deed of conveyance from Thomas Lewis to John Matlock
 was proven before Robert Nelson Esquire by the oath of Vincent Lewis
 and Recorded this 21th of March 1790

This Indenture made the Twenty ninth day of October one
 thousand seven hundred and eighty nine and of the Independance of
 of the united states of America the fourteenth between Thomas Lewis
 of the state of South Carolina and County of Guenwille of the one part
 and John Matlock of the State and County aforesaid of the other Part
 Witnesseth that the said Thomas Lewis for and in consideration of
 the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the
 said John Matlock the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the
 said Thomas Lewis hath Granted bargained and sold Aliened and confirm-
 -ed and by these presents doth bargain and sell, alien, and confirm unto
 the said John Matlock his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation
 or Tract of land containing three hundred and fifty Acres (be the same
 more or less) Situate in the County of Guenwille on mountain creek
 of Saluda River, beginning at a Heyory 3+ near the mouth of the long
 branch thence thence N. E. 76 76 chains to Stake on the line of the
 Original survey thence S W 19 75 chains to Stake 3+ thence S W 66 29
 chains to mountain creek thence the meanders of the creek to the
 beginning being part of a Tract of Land Originally Granted to Patrick
 Laffety on the Sixth day of September 1785 and Recorded in the
 Secretarys office Book F. F. F. page 41 Reference being being therunto
