This Indenture made this thirteenth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety and in the 14th year of American Independance between William Right of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the first Part and Henry M Wood of the State aforesaid and County of Spartanburgh of the other, part Witnesseth that the said William Right for and in consid- eration of fifty pounds Sterling money to him in hand paid by the said Henry M Wood at and before the Sealing and delivery of these pre- sents the Receipt whereof the said William Right doth hereby acknow- ledge himself fully satisfied & paid have given Granted bargained and sold, and by these presents doth give grant bargain and Sell unto the said Henry M Wood a certain Tract or Parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina Originally Granted to William Right which will appear by a Grant bearing date the first day of January one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Seven being part of said Tract of two hundred and forty seven Acres more or less and are bounded as follows Beginning at a White Oak corner of Dan. Kelly's line N 11 W 1/4 chain to a Poplar N 73 E 6: 50 to a
