State of South Carolina Queneville County May the Seventeenth one thousand seven hundred and ninety. sundry papers belonging to the estate of the late Captain Gerard Robinson of King-George County Virginia Mariner, was presented into Court by John Grigsby Administrator on the estate of the said Gerard - Robinson deceased and late from said County of King George and common wealth of Virginia; which on motion of the said John Grigsby was ordered to be Recorded and Certified

I know all men by these presents that I Gerard Robinson of King George County in Virginia Mariner am held and firmly bound to William Skyrin of Whitehaven in the County of Cumberland, Merchant in the Sum of seventy two pounds nine Shillings a half pence of good and lawful money of Great Britain to be paid to the said William Skyrin or his certain attorney Executors Administrators or assigns. I bind myself my heirs Executors Administrators and each of them firmly by these presents sealed with my Seal and dated this Twenty first day of November in the Seventh year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George the third by the grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King defender of the faith and so forth and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Sixty Seven

The condition of this Obligation is such that if the above bound Gerard Robinson his heirs Executors or administrators shall and do well and Truly Pay or cause to be Paid unto the above named William Skyrin his Executors Administrators or assigns, the full Sum of thirty six pounds four Shillings and
