


We Francis Bremer and Peter Freneau for and in consideration of the sum of Ten Shillings to us in hand paid at and before the sealing and delivery hereof do assign unto John Pyles in Trust for the children of Samuel Pyles deceased all our Right Title and Interest to six hundred and forty Acres of Land Situate in Ninety six District on both sides of Reddy River including the mouth of Stony Creek bounded to the South by James Lesleys Land all other sides by Vacant Land In Witness whereof we have hereunto set our hands and Seals this 25th day of January 1790

The following lease & Release from Benjamin Rice To Jesse Moody was proven before George Salmon Esq^r by the Oath of Jeremiah Smith and Recorded this 23rd July 1790.

This Indenture made the sixth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty six and in the eleventh year of the Independance of the united States of America between Benjamin Rice of Laurence County and State of South Carolina Planter of the one part and Jesse Moody of the County and State aforesaid Planter of the Other Part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Rice for and in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Jesse Moody the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Benjamin Rice hath bargained and sold and by these Presents doth bargain and sell all that plantation or Tract of land containing Two hundred Acres being part of a Tract of four hundred Acres of Land Granted unto Benjamin Rice by Grant bearing date the fifteenth day of October one thousand seven hundred and eighty four Situate on the waters of the Golden Grove Creek a branch of Saluda River above the antient boundary line bounded SW by James Seaborn's land and Nathaniel Pendletons having such Shape forms and marks as are Represented to a plat thereunto annexed and further by a conditional line agreed upon by the said Benjamin Rice and Jesse Moody sheweth that all that plantation or Tract of Two hundred Acres of Land be the same more or less Together with all and Singular the houses Out Houses Edifices, Buildings barns, Stables, Yards, Gardens, Orchards, woods under woods, Timber, and Timber Trees, Meadows, pastures, Ponds, Lakes, Fishings ways, waters water-courses Paths and passages, Liberties privileges, Profits Hereditaments, Rights members and appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in anywise appertaining and the Reversions or Reversions Remainders Rents Issues and profits thereof and every part and Parcel thereof To have and To hold the said plantation or Tract of Two
