209 The following deed of Conveyance from Isaac Clayton to William Towns
 was produced in Open Court August Term 1790 and acknowledged by the
 said Isaac Clayton and Ordered to be Recorded - Recorded this 15th day of
 November 1790.

This Indenture made the 14th day of August in the year of
 our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and ninety and in the Fifteenth
 year of the American Independance between Isaac Clayton of the State
 of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part & William
 Towns of Halifax County and State of Virginia of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Isaac Clayton for and in consideration of the
 sum of Two hundred Pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said
 William Towns the Receipt whereof the said Isaac Clayton doth
 hereby acknowledge he the said Isaac Clayton hath Granted Bargained
 and Sold aliened and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said William Towns his heirs
 and assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of Land containing Four
 hundred acres be the same more or less Situate in the County aforesaid
 on the Branches of ~~Reedy River~~ Saluda River beginning at a chestnut
 Station on said Claytons Old Line at the crossing of a Branch thence up
 said Branch to the mouth of Meathers Spring Branch thence up &c.
