This Indenture made the ninth day of August in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven and in the
Ninth year of the Independance of the united States of America be-
tween Thomas Wood of the state of South Carolina & Camden District
of the one part and Solomon West of the state aforesaid and ninety
six District of the other part Whereas in and by a certain Grant bear-
ing date the second day of May one thousand seven hundred and Eighty
Five from under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire
Governor for the time being did give and Grant unto Thomas Wood a
Tract of Three hundred Acres of Land situate in the district of ninety
six above the ancient boundary line on Mucklas branch a branch
of Beady River and hath such shape form and marks bullings & bound-
ings as appears by a plat to said Grant annexed the said plat and Grant
being duly Recorded in the secretary's Office Witnesseth that the said
Thomas Wood for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred Pounds
current money to him the said Thomas Wood in hand well and Truly Paid
the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Thomas Wood
hath Granted bargained & sold & by these presents doth Grant bargain
& sell unto the said Solomon West his heirs and assigns for ever and
the above named three hundred Acres of Land and also all houses or
houses Building Trees Woods under Woods Liches Commons and Common
