The following deed of conveyance from Joseph McLaughlin to Thomas Bell was produced before Rob<sup>t</sup>. Nelson Esquire and Recorded this 10th day of November A<sup>d</sup>. 1790.

This Indenture made the Twenty Eighth day of December in the year of Our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and eighty seven nine and in the Thirteenth year of the Independance of the united States of America between Joseph McLaughlin of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the one part and Thomas Bell of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, whereas by a certain Grant bearing date the Thirteenth day of August A<sup>d</sup>. one thousand Seven hundred and eighty six from under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire Governor and Commander in chief in and over the State aforesaid having the great seal of the State hereunto affixed being for that purpose appointed did give and Grant unto the said Joseph McLaughlin a plantation or Tract of land containing Three hundred and Forty acres situate and lying on Pinces Creek of Enoree River and hath such Form and marks cuttings and bounding as appears by the said Plat annexed which s<sup>r</sup>. Plat & Grant being duly Recorded in the Secretaries Office Book P.P.P. Page 609 Reference being had thereto may more fully appear now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Joseph McLaughlin for an in consideration of the sum of nineteen Pounds to him in hand well and lawly paid by the said Thomas Bell before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged here Grant- ed Bargained and Sold and by these presents doth bargain & Sell & confirm unto him the said Thomas Bell one hundred acres of the above described Tract of Land together with the woods waters heridatements and appurtenances to the said Land belonging or in any wise appurtaining &
