The following deed of Conveyance from Daniel Bush to Isam Clay²³⁶
ton was produced in Open Court November Term 1790 by the said Daniel
Bush, acknowledged by the same and Ordered to be Recorded —
Recorded this 9th day of December 1790.

This Indenture made the Thirteenth day of November in the
year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety and in the Four-
teenth year of American Independance between Daniel Bush of Green-
ville County and State of South Carolina of the one part and Isam
Clayton of the County and State aforesaid of the other part, whereas in and by
a certain Grant bearing date the first in the year one thousand seven hundred
and eighty five December the fifth Granted unto the said Isam Clayton from
under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r Governor for the time
being the second Granted unto Timothy Toney the fifteenth day of October
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Four from
under the hand of his Excellency Benjamin Guirard Esq^r Governor for
the time being the Third Granted unto Daniel Bush the sixth day of Febru-
ary in the year one thousand seven hundred and eighty six from under
the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r Governor for the time
being these Grants the first Granted unto the said Isam Clayton for one
hundred and eighty Acres the second Granted unto Timothy Toney
for Two hundred and fifty Acres the third Granted unto Daniel Bush
for Two hundred and Twenty five Acres, the Fourth Granted unto James
Henderson for one hundred and seventy eight Acres from under the
hand of his Excellency Benjamin Guirard Esq^r Governor for the time being
which plats to the said Grants annexed being duly Recorded in the
Secretaries Office Witnesseth that the said Daniel Bush for and in consid-
eration of the sum of Three hundred Pounds Current Money to
him the said Daniel Bush in hand well and Truly Paid the Price
whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Daniel Bush hath
