

243 The following Deed of Conveyance from ~~Beaten~~ ^{William} Stringer to Thomas McCarrel was produced in Open Court proven before Rob^t. C. Nelson Esq^r & Ordered to be Recorded, Recorded this 27th day of December 1790

This Indenture made this 29th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety in the fourteenth of American Independence between William Stringer of the one part & Tho^s. McCarrel of the other part both of the state of South Carolina ninety six District witnesses that the s^r Beaten Stringer for & in consideration of the sum of forty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the s^r Thomas McCarrel before the sealing & delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged hath Given Granted & Sold & by these presents doth give Grant bargain sell alien Release convey and confirm unto the s^r Thomas McCarrel & to his heirs & assigns for ever a Tract of land lying and being in the state aforesaid in Greenville County on both sides Black Gum 313 Smiths Spanish Oak 37 chernut 3 Vacant land to Chednut 3 Pine 3 poplar 3 post oak 34 Vacant land to Smiths Gum poplar 34 & 8^o 59 6 79-40 pine 34 white Oak pine & 4^o 70-10-28 Black Gum to the First Station Dam ninety six District Creek Forms Cuttings & Boundings as the above plat Represents Certified the 22 Day of January 1785 set Gen as by Reference thereto had may more fully & at large appear Together with all the woods ways water courses Buildings Improvements appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or any wise appertaining & the Reversion & Reversions for ever free & Clear from all
