244 The following deed of Conveyance from John Dyche to David Ree was proven
before Blackburn Esq^r produced in Open Court & ordered to be Recorded. —
Recorded this 27th day of December A.D. 1790

This Indenture made the 3rd day may & May 8 in the year of our Lord one
thousand Seven hundred & Ninety & in the Fourteenth year of the Independence of
America between John Dyche of Greenville County & State of South Carolina of
the one part & David Ree of the County & State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth
that the s^r John Dyche for & in consideration of the sum of Twenty five pounds
sterling & money to him in hand paid at & before the sealing & delivering of these
presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & him the s^r John Dyche hath
Bargained sold Releas'd & Confirmed & by these presents doth Grant Bargain &
Release unto David Ree his heirs or assigns one certain piece of land containing
Fifty acres be the same more or less tituate lying & being in a Ninety six District
on the waters of Rockey Fork of Golden Grove Creek being part of a tract of land Grant-
ed to Richard Good by his Excellency Benjamin Franklin Esq^r dated the Twenty first day
of Jan^r one thousand Seven hundred & eighty five beginning on a white Oak running
South across the s^r Fork eighty pole to a post Oak from thence S 70 E to a post Oak
from thence N 25 E to a red Oak from thence along a conditional line to the begin-
ning together with all appurtenances thereunto belonging part & parcel thereof unto
the s^r David Ree his heirs & assigns for ever to have & to hold the s^r piece of land
afores^d together with all premises & every thing thereunto belonging the s^r John
Dyche for himself his heirs & assigns doth Covenant & agree to and with the
s^r David Ree his heirs & assigns that they shall & may at all times hereafter
have & possess the aforesaid land without the least molestation of him the
s^r John Dyche his heirs Exec^t Adm^r to him the s^r David Ree his heirs Exec^t
& Adm^r to do warrant & defend the afores^d land from & against all Claim
or Claims that now is or hereafter may be made by any person or persons what-
