 produced in Open Court & proven by the Oath of Hugh M'ray & Ordered to be
 Recorded, which was done this 15th day of March A D 1791

This Indenture made the 10th day of January in the year of our Lord one
 thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the Fifteenth year of the Independence of the
 united States of America between John Stanford of Greenville County of the one part
 & David M'ray of the S^c County of the Other part Witnesseth that the S^r John Stanford
 for & in consideration of the sum of Fifty Pounds to him in hand paid by the said
 David M'ray at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof
 is hereby Acknowledged hath Granted Bargained sold aliened Inforced Conveyed &
 Confirmed unto & by these presents doth Grant Bargain sell alien convey and con-
 firm unto the said David M'ray his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract or
 parcel of Land containing Two hundred and Forty three acres lying and being
 situate in the County of Greenville State of S^c Carolina District of Chincoteague
 on the waters of Saluda it being part of a Tract Granted to John Stanford said
 Grant containing three hundred & Forty three acres dated the Fifth day of February
 one thousand seven hundred & Eighty seven & under the hand of the Honourable
 William Moultrie Esq^r and Great seal of the state for that Purpose appointed
 and duly recorded in the secretaries Office of the said State Reference hereunto
 had & may more fully appear which Tract of Two hundred and Forty Three acres
 more or less runs as follows Beginning at a Black Sack a Corner in S^c Tract
