This Indenture made this eighth day of December the year of our
 Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety & in the Fifteenth year of the
 Independance of the united States of America between Randolph Casey
 & Charity Casey his wife of the County of Greenville & state of S^c Carolina Planter
 of the one part & John Stanford Jun^r of the same County & state aforesaid Planter
 of the other part Witnesseth that whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing
 date the fifth day of December one thousand seven hundred & eighty five
 under the hand of William M^rartin Esq^r Governour & commander in chief in &
 over the state aforesaid having the great seal of the state aforesaid therunto
 affixed did give & Grant unto the said Randolph Casey a Tract of land
 containing Two hundred acres situate lying & being in Greenville County
 in the District of Ninety six on the south fork of S^c Tiger River joining Caswell
 land beginning at a Red Oak Running South forty six & East forty four & to
 a stake thence South forty four & East West forty four & to a stake Oak
 thence North forty six & West forty four & to a stake thence North
 forty four & East forty four & to the beginning containing the above
