The following deed of conveyance from Andrew Jones & Elizabeth Jones to Thomas Townsen was proven in Open Court by the Oath of Jesse Webb and ordered to be Recorded which was done this 23rd day of March 1791

This Indenture made the 18th day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety one, between Andrew Jones of the state of south Carolina and County of Greenville of the first part and Thomas Townsen late of the state of Virginia of the second part Witnesseth that the s^d Andrew Jones for & in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Townsen the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the s^d Andrew Jones hath Bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do Bargain & sell alien and confirm unto the said Thomas Townsen his heirs and assigns for ever all that Plantation or Tract of Land containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres beginning at a white oak st on the South West of Horse Creek thence running across s^d Creek on the Original line e N 23° E 52 chains to a white oak st thence due West 5 1/2 chains 50 links to a Hycory thence due e N 22 chains to a Spanish Oak thence S 70 N 23 ch^s to Horse Creek to a Stake thence down s^d Creek to line of mark'd Trees Including the Mill Shoal of said Creek and down s^d Creek to the Beginning, being part of a Tract of Land Originally Granted to Jesse
