273 The following act of Conveyance from William Story to Bryan Ward
 Nowlin was presented in Open Court & acknowledged by the S^d William
 Story & ordered to be Recorded which was done this 23rd March 1791

This Indenture made the 1st day of March one thousand seven hun-
 dred & ninety & in the fourteenth year of the Independence of the United
 States of America between William Story of Greenville County of the State
 S^t Carolina of the one part & Bryan Ward Nowlin of the other part of the
 County & state afores^t Witnesseth that the S^d William Story for & in considera-
 tion of the sum of sixty pounds to him in hand paid by the S^d Bryan Ward
 Nowlin the receipt whereof the S^d William Story doth hereby acknowledge
 he the S^d William Story hath Granted Bargained & sold aliened & confirmed
 by these presents doth Grant Bargain & sell alien & confirm unto the
 S^d Bryan Ward Nowlin his heirs & assigns for ever all that plantation or
 tract of land containing one hundred acres, be the same more or less situate
 in the County aforesaid on a branch of Reedy River Granted on the
 First day of May 1786 Recorded in the Surveyor's Office Grant Book —
