State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that Solomon
Humphreys of Pendleton district in the State aforesaid, in consideration of
fifty ^{five} Dollars to me paid by Roger Smith of Greenville District in the State
aforesaid, Have granted bargained sold and Released, and by this presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Roger Smith all that tract
or parcel of Land containing one hundred and ninety acres be the same
more or less, situate in Greenville District on a branch of Clear Creek of South Tyger
River, including the crossing of the County and Market Roads in said District
bounded by Enoch Benson, Abalom Barney's corners, & George Sanders lands —
Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments & appurtenances
to the said Premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have & to
Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Roger Smith his
heirs and assigns forever, and I hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators
to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Roger
Smith his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whom
soever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof. Witness my hand
and seal this Eighth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight
hundred and Eleven, and in the thirty fifth year of the Independence of the United States
of America. Signed sealed and delivered in presence of us.
