acknowledge Have granted sold and Released and by these presents do grant
bargain sell Release and confirm and deliver unto the said William Austin
his heirs executors admors and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land lying
in the district aforesaid, and on the waters of Darbans Creek, containing or by estimation one hundred
acres be the same more or less it being part of a tract of Land originally granted to Joseph
Reed by his excellency Charles Pinckney on the seventh day of May in the year 1790
Beginning on Hickory running N. 20 E to Penick's road thence up said road to a Red
Oak corner of Towor's thence along Towor's line unto the original line of said tract
thence by said old line to the Beginning, Together with all and singular the Premises
Tenements hereditaments and appurtenances hereto belonging or in any wise appertain
-ing
