 The State of South Carolina, I know all men by these presents that Jason
 Plant of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of
 of the sum of Four hundred and fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by Archabell
 Clayton Reynolds of the State and District aforesaid have granted bargained
 sold and released, and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release
 unto the said Archabell C. Reynolds one house and lot of land situate lying &
 being in the village of Pleasantburg near Greenville Courthouse known and
 distinguished in the plan or chart of said village by the number forty seven
 N.W. lying on the East side of the street which leads from the Courthouse
 Northwardly. Beginning on a stake on the side of the street running North fifteen
 & a half degrees East one hundred feet to a stake, thence South Seventy four
 & a half degrees East one hundred and seventy six 8/4 feet to a stake, thence South
 fifteen & a half degrees West one hundred feet to a stake, thence North Twenty
 four & a half degrees West one hundred and seventy six 8/4 feet to the Beginning,
 containing one half acre be the same more or less, the same having been
 conveyed from Samuel J. Atton to John W. Wood from Wood to Thomas Alexander
 from Alexander to Gipso Goodlett from Goodlett to Samuel A. Earley from
 Earley to John Archer from Archer to me, Together with all and singular
 the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises
 belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining, To have & to hold all
 and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Archabell C.
 Reynolds his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs
 executors and administrators to warrant and forever defend all singular
 the said Premises unto the said Archabell C. Reynolds his heirs and assigns
 against myself & my heirs and against every other Person or Persons
 whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
 Witness my hand and seal this first day of December in the year of our
 one thousand eight hundred and ten, and in the thirty fifth year
 of the American Independence, Signed sealed and delivered
 in the presence of, John Archer
