This Indenture made this Eleventh day of August one thousand eight hundred & three
between James McAfee and Patty his wife of the State of South Carolina & of Pendleton
district of the one Part and Hugh Parks of the aforesaid State & district of Greenville
of the other part. Witnesseth that the said James & Patty McAfee for and in consi-
deration of the sum of Two hundred and fifty Dollars to them in hand paid by
the said Hugh Parks the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said James
and Patty McAfee hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth
bargain and sell unto the said Hugh Parks a certain tract or piece of Land
Containing two hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less, it being a tract
of land originally granted to Henry Stover containing two hundred acres and part
of a tract originally granted to Edmund Peters. Beginning at a Post oak on Stovers
line and running N: 85 E: 12.50 to a pine thence N: 10 E: 36.70 to Enoree River thence
up the river to the mouth of Wolf Creek, thence up said Wolf Creek to the mouth
of the first branch, thence up s^t branch to Stovers line near Stovers Post oak corner
thence S: 70 W: 36.72 to a stake by a hickory thence S: 20 E: 44.72 to a black Jack
thence N: 70 E: 44.72 to a rock corner by a holly thence N: 20 W: to the Beginning
which said tract of Land of two hundred fifty acres more or less, with all and
every of its appurtenances, the said James & Patty doth from themselves and their heirs and
from all and every other person or persons will warrant and forever defend to the said
Hugh Parks his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof the said James and
Patty McAfee hath hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year above
written. Signed sealed & delivered in presence of "the word to a man of fifty" James McAfee Seal
