State of South Carolina Greenville District. Know all men by these presents that I Nathaniel Jackson of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and Eighty five Dollars to me in hand paid by George Russell of the District aforesaid have granted bargained sold & Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said George Russell a tract of land of one hundred and fourteen acres be the same more or less being part of a tract of 350 acres of land granted to Rubbin Barrett by Mr. Moultrie the 3^d day of October 1785. in Greenville District on Pack creek a branch of Tyger River which said land hath been conveyed from the above Barrett to Benjamin Ellis and from said Ellis to John Stanford and from said Stanford to Nathaniel Jackson Beginning on a white oak on Callaway's branch of Packs creek waters of Tyger River thence down the meander of said branch to Packs creek, thence up the meander of said creek to the mouth said Russell's Hill House branch, thence up the meander of said branch to a maple at the ford at said branch, thence N^o. 80 E. 14 chains 84 links to a lightwood stake, and pointers on the Eastward line of the original survey thru N^o. 10 W. 19 chains 50 links to a dead Spanish oak, thence to the Beginning corner. Together with all and singular the rights, members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said land & premises belonging or in any wise appertain thereto. To have & to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said George Russell his heirs and assigns and do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said George Russell his heirs & assigns against myself and all other persons whom ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, Witness my hand and seal in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and Eleven April the twelfth in the presence of us Just Thomas Jackson, Andrew M. Cray J.P.
