

State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that I Moses Wood of Greenville District in the State aforesaid for and in consideration of Five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by William Wood of the said State and district, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, Have granted bargained & sold, conveyed & confirmed unto the said Mr. Wood all them Plantations, tracts or parcels of Land contained on the south side of the South fork of Tyger River bounded by Robert Nelson, John Sparks, George Lybreath Ford and Sons & Moses Wood in side of Rays claim, to contain three hundred acre more or less, reference may be had to the deed from William Poe to said Moses Wood, To Have & To hold the said three hundred acre of land with all its rights, members and appurtenances whatsoever therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Mr. Wood and the said Moses Wood his heirs Executors Administrators unto the said William Wood his heirs & assigns, the said granted premises of Three hundred acre more or less will warrant and forever defend against him the said Moses Wood his heirs and assigns and against all other Persons whatsoever In Testament whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and five, Signed Sealed and Delivered in Presence of us John Wood
