Lynch of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of One
hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Micajah Pickett of North Carolina
Rutherford County the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained
and sold unto the said M. Pickett a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the
State & District aforesaid on the waters of the North fork of Saluda River having such
bounds and marks as hereafter mentioned Beginning at the mouth of the still house branch
on a white o. corner running up the East fork of the branch near the head of the same
near a rock house, thence running by a Rock house to the top of the hill to a poplar
tree corner near the road thence running to a chestnut oak tree blazed by the
party, thence running the course of the plot till the line intersect Mr. Cornelius
line, thence running on said Cornelius line a S.W. course till it intersects the new
Market line running round the same on the East side & south side till the line
strikes the still house branch, thence running down the branch to the Beginning
corner containing by estimation fifty acres be the same more or less which tract
or parcel of land which was granted to me the said Mr. Lynch by his Excellency
Edward Rutledge Governor Commander in Chief in and over the said State —
the ninth day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and
ninety nine, I do hereby warrant and forever defend all and singular the said
premises unto the said Micajah Pickett his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs
and against every other Person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
