eration of the sum of four hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by Daniel  
McKee of the same state and district of Spartanburgh, Have granted bargained  
sold and released, and by these presents Do grant bargain sell & release  
unto the said Daniel McKee all that plantation or tract of land containing  
Two hundred and fifty acres the same being more or less, it being the  
land and mill whereon I now live it being part of two grants one originally  
to David Lewis the other to Nathaniel Walker agreeable to two deeds  
to me the one from David Lewis for one hundred acres the other from  
William Harbin sen. for two hundred acres the Lewis deed covering part  
of William Harbins deed Together with all singular the rights members, nec-  
essary appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining  
To have & To hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Daniel  
McKee his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> and  
admo<sup>rs</sup> to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the  
said Daniel McKee his heirs and assigns, against myself & my heirs, and against  
every person whomsoever Lawfully claiming, or to claim the same or any part thereof  
Witness my hand and seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of March in the year of our Lord  
One thousand Eight hundred and twelve, and in the thirty sixth year of the  
Independence of the United States of America, Signed Sealed & Delivered in the presence  
of Thomas Parks, Banister Stone, Blagrove Glenn
