South Carolina. Know all men by these presents, that I Henry Jones
of Greenville District and State aforesaid, for and in consideration of the sum of
Two hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by William Bramblet of the
district and State aforesaid, have granted bargained sold and released, and
by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Mr Bramblet
a plantation or tract of land lying and being situate in the State and district
aforesaid, on the waters of Quidary it being a part of a tract of land of 500 acres
originally gr^d to John Weekly by his Excellency William Moultrie on the 4th
Sept. 1785. and conveyed through different hands down to the said Henry
Jones, the land to be conveyed begins on Spanish oak 3+ on runs N. 15 W.
cornering to stake by scrugs fenced thence N.E. to the branch then up the
various courses of the said branch to the old line, then N. 75 E. to stake
thence S. 75 E. 47.50 to stake in the old line, thence to the beginning, and
also including part of a tract that was originally granted to James Wafford
and conveyed through different hands down to the said Jones, this part
begins on stake on Daniel Richardson's line, runs N. 15 W. 25 ch. to pine
3+ then S. 80 E. 8 ch. to pine 3+ then S. 68 E. 14 ch. to pine 3+ run, then East
13 ch. bounded by Johnston's line to the line of the other tract then with
said line cornering to stake which is Richardson's corner then West with
said line to the beginning, including in all one hundred and fifty acres
be the same more or less, Together with all and singular the rights, members,
hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any
wise incident or appertaining, To have and to hold all and singular the
Premises before mentioned unto the said Mr Bramblet his heirs and assigns
forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs, Executors & adm^{rs} to warrant
and forever defend all and singular all and singular the Premises
before mentioned unto the said Mr Bramblet his heirs and assigns against
myself and my heirs and against every other person whomsoever lawfully claim-
ing or to claim the same or any part thereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 22nd July 1806.

and made oath in due form of law and saith that he was present and saw
Henry Jones assign & deliver the within deed of conveyance to William Bramblet
for the use and purpose within mentioned, also saw John Thackston assign the
same as a concurring witness with himself sworn to and subscribed before me
