William Reed came before me and saith on his oath that he was present and did see John Anderson sign and as his act and deed deliver the within deed of conveyance to said Ray for the use and purposes therein mentioned, and that he saw William Smith subscribed his name as a witness with himself to the same, sworn to and subscribed the day and date above written, Before me, Hudson Berry J.D. State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I James Alexander of Greenville district and state aforesaid, for and in consideration of two hundred dollars to me in hand paid by John Alexander of district and state aforesaid have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said John Alexander a parcel or tract of land containing one hundred and seventy six acres of land more or less situated on a branch of Reedy River in the State & District aforesaid being a part of a tract of land originally granted to said James Alexander bearing date the fourth day of July one thousand seven hundred and eighty five containing three hundred fifty two this land laid out by a conditional line running across the said tract. Beginning on a Post oak marked F.A. on John Pedens line near the road that leads from the widow Pedens to said James Alexander, thence S: 80 W: untill it strikes the flat Rock branch thence down said branch untill it strikes the original line thence with the line to the corner a spanish oak thence S: 50 E: 17 chains fifty links to a spanish oak thence S: 10 E: 22 chains to a pine thence S: 50 E: 22 chains to a pine thence N: 50 E: 15 450 links to a black oak and from thence to the Beginning marked post oak. Together with all and singular the rights members and Hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining; To have & To hold all and singular the premises above mentioned unto the said John Alexander his heirs and assigns forever, And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to man and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said John Alexander his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.
