these presents that I John Chandler son of Rob^t. of the State and district
aforesaid in consideration of Two hundred and twenty five Dollars to me
paid by Hudson Berry of the said State and district hath granted bargained
sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & Release
unto the said Hudson Berry a plantation and part of two original tracts
of Land both granted to Jepé Chandler one bearing date the 5. day of January
1789 the other bearing date the 25. day of January 1785. Thena conveyed
round to said John Chandler now from said John Chandler to said Hudson
Berry, part of the said tract^y. Beginning at a poplar running S. 38^{W.} 27.^{E.} 50
to a persimmon thorn N. 67^{W.} 11.^{E.} 5 ch. to a hickory thence S. 10^{W.} 19.^{E.} ch. to a Spanish
Oak thence S. 74^{E.} 10 ch. to a hickory thence S. 61^{E.} 33.^{S.} 50 to a stake thence N. 5.^{E.}
21.^{S.} 20 to a stake thence N. 67^{W.} 4.^{E.} 40 to a R. oak, thence N. 5.^{E.} 12.^{S.} 50.
to a white oak thence to the Beginning; Including the plantation wheron said
Chandler now lies, together with one hundred and twenty two acres of land
situate in said district of Greenville on Carrol^t Branch of Horse creek waters of
Rude River. Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments
and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise incident or
appertaining, To have and To hold all and singular the premises before
mentioned unto the said Hudson Berry his heirs and assigns forever, And I
do hereby bind myself my heirs, executors and administrators to warrant and
forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Hudson Berry
his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person
whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
So witness my hand and seal this 25th day of January 1808, this in the
thirty third year of the Independence of the United States of America.
