State of South Carolina Greenville district, Know all men by these presents that I John Ford of the State and district aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty dollars to me in hand paid by Geargan Cornit of the State and district aforesaid Hath granted bargained and sold and released unto the said Geargan Cornit and his heirs all that tract of land or plantation containing one hundred and sixty one acres be the same more or less situate in the State and district aforesaid on the waters of the reedy fork of Ruddy River adjoining on the West by Robert Russell and on the north supposed by Beals and on the S.E. by said Cornit and Martin Collihan and on the other side by George Brooks and originally granted to Hewlet Sullivan and a part to William Pop. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances unto the aforesaid premises belonging or in any wise appertaining, To have &c hold all and singular the Premises before mentioned unto the said Geargan Cornit his heirs and assigns forever, and I John Ford do hereby bind myself my heirs and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Geargan Cornit his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and every other person whatsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof, In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day of September 1808. and the thirty second year of the Independence of the United States of America, Signed sealed and delivered in presence of
