

108) William Clayton by patent bearing date the 6th May in the year 1790 from him conveyed to W^m White, & from said White to myself, beginning at a R. O. near the ridge road, & running thence S 38 W 24^{ch} to B. Ok on my line thence S 47 E with said Whittens line 45^{ch} to a W. Ok near a branch thence up that branch the varying meanders near the head to a pine thence N 40 E 8.50^{ch} to a chestnut on another line of mine, thence N. 80 W. 20^{ch} with my line to a chestnut my corner thence to the beginning supposed to contain one hundred acres be the same more or less - One other parcel of land, being a part of the last mentioned Survey, and known by the Widow Burkes Land, beginning on a Chestnut "running" N 85 W. 31^{ch} to a Chestnut, thence S. 22 W. 9^{ch} to a pine thence S 40 W. 10.80^{ch} to a Stake, thence S 47 E 31.50^{ch} to a B. Ok, thence N. 39 W. 10^{ch} to a Chestnut Ok, thence N. 10 E. 16^{ch} crossing of the creek to a B. Ok sapling an Old Corner, thence S. 60 E. 16.50^{ch} to a Chestnut thence S. 40 E. 29.50^{ch} to a pine, thence S. 40 W. 10.80^{ch} to my corner a Stake, thence S 17 W. to the beginning supposed to contain seventy five acres be the same more or less. Another parcel of Land a part of the last mentioned plat convey^d from said Maxwell to John Heddleton from him him to W^m Laughlin Senr. & John his son, & by them to Isham Burke and from him to Richard Brasel and from him to Nathaniel Gentry, & from him to Jeremiah Brown & from him to me beginning on a R. Ok in the fork of Greens Creek running S 20 W. crossing the river to a B. Ok, thence to a Pine on David H. line thence N. 10 W. 11.50^{ch} to a Pine, thence N 60 W 7^{ch} to a Chestnut Ok, thence N 10 W. 19^{ch} crossing the river to a R. Ok thence N 60 E to a Stake thence S 39 E to a B. Ok thence S. 28 E 15 ch. to a B.
