Williams All that tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the district and State aforesaid, Containing forty acres, be the same more or less, beginning on a red Oak corner Conditionally made between Ambrose Blackburn and Levi Sallyear ^{car.} on George Goodwin old line, thence along a conditional line to a red Oak corner from thence to John Clements Post Oak corner, from thence along said Clements line to said Goodwin, Stake corner, from thence along said Goodwin line to the beginning corner - To have and to hold the before mentioned premises with the appurtenances to the said Thomas B. William his heirs & assigns forever - And I do hereby warrant and forever will defend the before mentioned premises to the said Thomas B. Williams his heirs and assigns against me & my Heirs, and against the claims or claims of all persons or persons, whomsoever.
