Dollar, to me in hand paid by John Waldoop of the district aforesaid have granted  
bargained sold and released and by these Presents do grant bargain sell & release  
unto the said John Waldoop a Plantation or tract of land laying and being in the  
district aforesaid on a small Creek N. side of Salcolate River beginning  
~~thence N. 65° E. 39 ch to a red oak~~ <sup>thence N. 65° W. 4 ch 50 ft. E. 4 ch 50 ft. S. 17 E. 23 ch</sup> at a Spanish Oak and running thence N. 45 W. 9 Ch. to the Creek at the mouth  
of a branch on the N. side, thence up the various meanders of the branch to a  
Cherry tree N. 65 E. 28 ch 50 ft. to a black oak, Mr. Clines corner, thence with  
his line S. 45 E. 15 ch. to a red oak John Hickman's corner, thence with his  
line S. 17 E. 23 ch. to a Blk. Oak Moses White's corner, thence with his line S.  
W. corner crossing the Creek to the beginning, containing by estimation one  
hundred and seven acres, be the same more or less (being part of two tracts)  
the lower and supposed to be sixty acres granted to John Gaven by Patent bearing  
date October 3<sup>d</sup>. 1791 the other end & upper part granted by Patent to William
