The State of South Carolina Before the subscribers Clerks of the Court and Ex Traditor district of office one of the Justices of quorum in and for the the district aforesaid personally came and appeared Champ Langford who being sworn in due form of law sayeth on his oath that he did see Henry Langford sign seal and deliver on his act and deed and deliver the within and of conveyance for the use and purpose therein set forth and that Enoch Drutson was with himself a subscribing witness to the due execution of the same Terra and subscribed before me this 9th day of July 1813. State of South Carolina. Know all men by these presents that I Robert Redman of Spartanburgh District in the State aforesaid in Consideration of three hundred and fifty dollars to me paid by Fielden Southern of Spartanburgh district in the State aforesaid. Have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Fielden Southern a certain plantation or tract of Land containing by estimation one hundred and fifty acres lying in the district of Greenville and State aforesaid on a branch of brushy creek of Enore River it being a part of a tract of Land originally granted to Henry Hughes bearing date the fifth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Eighty seven. Whereas it beginning on a Post oak corner thence running S: 22 E: 35 to a stake corner thence S: 67 E: 25 to a stake from thence to Moses Kemps line thence along S: Kemps line to the corner from thence to a Spanish oak corner by the creek Johnsons line, along said Johnsons line to a line running N: 63 W: 20 to a stake from thence S: 30 W: 31: 02 to Aron Kemps line thence along said line to the beginning corner, also certain plantation or tract of Land containing by estimation fifty acres lying in the district of Greenville on the waters of brushy creek of Enore river and bounded on the north west side of the above described tract of Land. Beginning at a post oak corner originally belong to Paul Abner from thence along said line to bigby branch to Mr. Redmans corner thence down the said branch to brushy creek from thence down the meanders of said creek to maple stone which said tract of Land of fifty acres be the same more or less. Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises, belonging or in any wise incident or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Fielden Southern his heirs and assigns forever and I do hereby bind myself my heirs exors & administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said
