State and District aforesaid, hath granted bargained sold and Released, and by these presents do grant bargain and release unto the said Jesse Mayfield of the State and District aforesaid, a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the State and District aforesaid lying on the south side of Gap creek of the middle fork of Saluda containing one hundred and more or less. Beginning on a Spruce pine conditional line made between Jonathan Potts and Cannon thence running south to said old line thence along the said line to the south branch of said creek to the south fork of said branch thence down said branch to the mouth to a poplar corner thence up the creek to the Beginning corner on a Spruce Pine. It being a part of a tract of Land granted to Col Colcock surveyed for Ephraim Elles which S. Cannon hath sold said Mayfield. To have & To Hold the said Land and premises him his heirs and assigns against the said Cannon him his heirs and assigns or any other person or persons forever I do warrant and forever defend the said premises unto Jesse Mayfield from all persons having any lawful claim signed sealed and delivered in the presence of us this 14th day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirteen
