This Indenture made the seventeenth day of December in the Year of  
Our Lord, one Thousand Seven Hundred & Ninety Two and in the seventeenth  
Year of the Independance of America. Between Lewis Duvall of Greenville  
County & State of South Carolina of the one part & William Wates of the  
County & State aforesaid of the other part, Witnesseth that the said Lewis Duvall  
for & in consideration of the sum of Ten pounds Sterling to him in hand well and  
truly paid by said William Wates at & before the <sup>sealing</sup> & delivery of these presents the  
whereof the said Lewis Duvall doth hereby acknowledge and of and from every  
part & parcel thereof do acquit & discharge the said William Wates his heirs & assigns  
and & for divers other good causes and considerations hereunto moving do Grant bar  
-gain sell alien enfee off & confirm unto the said William Wates his heirs and  
assigns forever Twenty acres of Land more or less lying on the south side of Reedy  
River in Greenville County being part of a tract of Land Granted to the said Lewis  
Duvall & signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the thirty first day of  
May in the Year of Our Lord one Thousand seven Hundred and Eighty six as  
by a plat annexed to said Grant will more fully appear. Being laid out  
unto the said William Wates as follows, Beginning on a black oak which  
stands on the south side of Reedy River below the Cherrikee shole from thence  
Running westward to a corner on a black oak which stands on the line of the  
above mentioned tract of Land, from thence running N 25. E. to a corner on a pine  
from thence running N. 65. E. to a corner on a willow oak on Reedy River, from  
thence running down & bounding on said Reedy River down to the beginning includ-  
ing Twenty acres or the same more or be it less, Together with all and singular the  
houses, out houses, ways, waters, paths, passages, trees, fences, Easements, hereditaments, &  
appurtenances whatsoever to the said Land so described as above belonging or in any  
wise appertaining and the reversion & reversions remainder & remainders rents issues &  
profits thereof & every part and parcel thereof, & all the estate right title interest claim &  
demand whatsoever in Law & Equity of the said Lewis Duvall of us & to the same premises
