of the sum of Five Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by William Davis  
Thomas of the State & District aforesaid have Granted bargained sold &  
released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the  
said William D Thomas all that Tract or parcel of Land containing  
five hundred acres (be the same more or less agreeable to the plat and  
Grant thereof) lying on the North side of the South fork of South Tyger  
River including all that lies on the North side of the river (as aforesaid) of a tract  
of six hundred and forty acres originally granted to Major Parsons and  
the whole of a tract of two hundred acres nearly adjoining thereto -  
Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appur-  
tenances to the said five hundred acres belonging or in any wise incident  
or appertaining. To have and to hold all and singular the premises aforesaid  
before mentioned unto the said W<sup>m</sup>. D Thomas his heirs & assigns forever  
And I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & administrators to war-  
rant and forever defend all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
the said William D Thomas his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs  
& against every person or persons whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim  
the same or any part thereof - Witness my hand & seal this first day of
